Common Assessments & Pacing Calendar Expectations

- Non-negotiable —found on CISD Curriculum Page under your specific grade-level
- Assessments will be uploaded to CISD
 Curriculum Page for copying
- Scantrons uploaded into DMAC within a week of the test. <u>Print scantrons ONLY to a copy</u> <u>machine; otherwise, these may not scan correctly</u>
- Plain paper scantrons -- uploaded into DMAC within 48 hours of test date - K - 1st Grades - 1 week
- Dark bubbling is required for Scantrons to be read through the systems
 - DMAC breaks down SEs: teachers, grade level, ethnicity, socio-economic, etc. This data drives reteaching!

About the Unit Assessments and Content on Pacing Calendar:

- Standards drive the Instruction for the Unit
- SEs within the particular unit on the pacing calendar are the SEs that will be on the common assessments
- Pacing calendar should keep you on target within a few days – not a few weeks
- Common Assessments are the GOAL of the unit content
