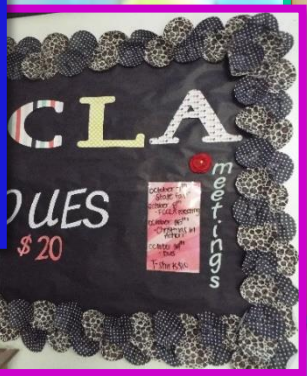
State Fair

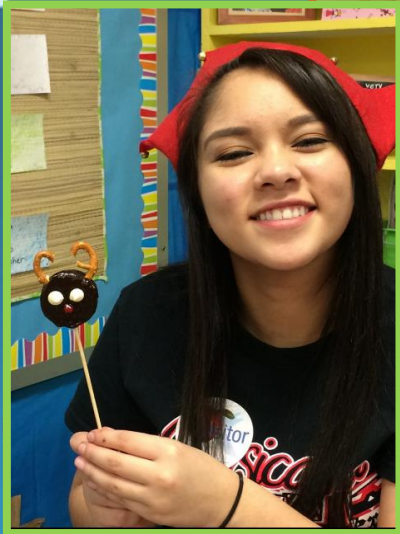
