A Summary of the Board of Trustees Meeting

November 27, 2023

The Board of Trustees of the Corsicana Independent School District met in a Board Meeting at 5:00 p.m. on Monday, November 27, 2023 at the Corsicana ISD Dr. Kent Rogers Administration Building, 2200 W. 4th Ave., Corsicana, Texas. The meeting was called to order by Dr. Seth Brown, President of the Board of Trustees.

Superintendent Report

Dr. Frost extended the District's appreciation to Will Thompson and all involved in awarding the CISD Police Department a Ballistic Shield. The Penguin Project will be December 15 and 16. This year the play is The Little Mermaid.

Navarro Central Appraisal District Ballot

CISD receives 1370 votes. On a motion by Leah Blackard and seconded by Barbara Kelley, the Board of Trustees voted to cast 800 votes for Ed Monk and 570 votes for Rosie Travenia.
