# Comprehensive Needs Assessment

## Demographics

### Demographics Summary

Corsicana High School's 2023-2024 enrollment is 1,820 students; 482 freshman, 464 sophomores, 503 juniors, and 372 seniors. Seventy Two percent of our students are economically disadvantaged. Our student body consists of the following ethnicities with their respective percentage of student body: Hispanic- 55%; White- 23%; Black- 15%; Pacific Islander- 3%; Asian- .65%; Multiple Ethnicities- 3%; American Indian .27%. CHS has a staff of 180 employees, one principal, one associate principal, four assistant principals, 3 coordinators, 2 LPC's and six counselors.

# Student Achievement

## Student Achievement Summary

Corsicana High School received a letter grade of ? on the 2023-2024 Texas Academic Performance Report.

2023 STAAR passing rates: English 1 59%, English 2 65%, Algebra 1 66%, Biology 81%, U.S. History 95%.

## Student Achievement Strengths

Corsicana High School had increased performance in the following areas:

1. Increase from 92% to 95% passing on US History EOC.
2. Increase from 77% to 81% passing on the Biology 1 EOC.
3. Increase from 65% to 66% passing on the Algebra 1 EOC.

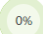
