PARENT PORTAL ON txCONNECT

Parent Portal on txConnect is an Internet-ready program that allows you, via your web browser, to access timely information about your student's progress in school. With just a click of the mouse, you will have access to view your student's schedule, attendance, and grades.

AVAILABLE INFORMATION:

Below, please find a list of available information about your student that you can access from the Parent Portal.

- **Course Schedule** – displays the courses in which your student is currently enrolled.
- **Attendance** – displays your student's attendance record.
- **Grades** – displays your student's progress, term and semester grades for each class.
- **Grade Book** – displays your student's assignments and test grades for each class.
- **Alerts** – allows parents to set up alerts regarding their student(s) attendance and grades

HOW TO SIGN UP FOR PARENT PORTAL:

- a. To begin using the Parent Portal, your child must be a registered student. New students to CISD will receive a parent portal letter from your child's campus. If you have students at multiple campuses, you will only need to register once to have access to all of your student(s) information.
 - b. If you forget your Parent Portal Password, you may go to the Parent Portal login page and click "Forgot Password?" Enter your email address in the appropriate field to have your password automatically sent to you.
 - c. To access the Parent Portal, please visit the Corsicana Independent School District's website at www.cisd.org and click "Grades" in the top right-hand corner of the page, or click "txConnect" on the left-hand side of the page under "Quick Links". This link will take to the Parent Portal login page.
 - d. Your login information will remain the same for each school year. If you are a returning user, you may use the same login information you used last year.
 - e. If you've lost your letter or if never received one, you may contact your student's campus secretary at any point during the school year and he/she will send home another letter.
