



CISD BOARD REPORT

A Summary of the Board of Trustees Meeting

June 5th & June 19th, 2017

The Board of Trustees of the Corsicana Independent School District held a board workshop on June 5, 2017 and a regular board meeting on June 19, 2017. The meetings were called to order by Mrs. Leah Blackard, President of the Board of Trustees.

Recognitions

At the June 19th meeting, CISD Police Officer Jeff Swanson and his son Tyler were recognized for winning the bronze medal at the Texas Police Olympic Games golf tournament in Dallas last week.



Carroll Elementary Principal

On a motion by John Saberton and seconded by Jason Sodd, the Board of Trustees voted to approve Cheryl Murdock as the Carroll Elementary Principal. The motion passed unanimously.



Fannin Assistant Principal

On a motion by Dr. Kent Rogers and seconded by Rev. Ed. Monk, the Board of Trustees voted to approve Shelly Dyer as the Assistant Principal of Fannin Elementary. The motion passed unanimously.



Communications Plan

Susan Johnson gave an overview of the Communications Plan. This includes ongoing projects as well as new strategies designed to strengthen and expand communications. The mission of the Communications Department is to effectively market Corsicana ISD by creating an aligned district/campus message and to provide information that educates our stakeholders about our students, staff, and district achievements, events, and initiatives. The Corsicana ISD is committed to open, honest, and ongoing communication with our stakeholders.

Dual Credit/Higher Start Update

Shonna Franklin gave an overview of the Dual Credit and Higher Start Program. Both programs have been very successful over the past three years.

TASB Delegate Designation

On a motion by Terry Seth and seconded by Rev. Ed Monk, the Board of trustees voted to approve John Saberton as the primary TASB Delegate and Jason Sodd as the alternate. The motion passed unanimously.

New Bus Discussion

At the June 5th meeting, Chris Gibbs presented quotes on a new special education bus to replace the bus that was totaled in an accident in the early spring. He presented quotes from two members of Buy Board. The vendors were Longhorn Bus Sales and Rush Bus Centers. He also advised the Board that the legislature has ruled that buses that are 2018 or newer will be required to have seat belts. If a district wants to opt out of having seat belts the district has to have a public hearing. At the June 19th meeting, on a motion by John Saberton and seconded by Ed Monk, the Board of Trustees voted to approve purchasing a new, 54 passenger bus with

seat belts and a wheelchair lift for the total price of \$96,712.00. The motion passed unanimously.

Budget for 2017-2018 School Year

Marti Shaner gave an overview of the budget for the 2017-2018 school year.

Instructional Supply Proposal

Marti Shaner gave an overview of the Instructional Supply proposal. Bids were taken for multiple items. The items will be distributed between bidders based on price.

Edgenuity Renewal

Marti Shaner gave an overview and the quote for renewing Edgenuity. This program will provide all the course work necessary for student's grades 6-12 to accelerate credits, recover credits, stay on target with graduation even if they have had disciplinary issues and pursue AP and CTE courses we currently do not offer.

Approval of Assistant Principal at Corsicana High School

On a motion by Terry Seth and seconded by John Saberton, the Board of Trustees voted to approve Bradley Thomason as Assistant Principal at Corsicana High School. The motion passed unanimously.

Approve Lunch Prices for 2017-2018 School Year

Chris Gibbs presented information over the current price for lunch at all campuses: \$1.95 at the elementary schools, \$2.35 at CHS and CMS, and staff meals across the district are \$3.00. In order to stay in compliance with the state and federal guidelines, CISD must raise all meals by \$0.10. On a motion by John Saberton and seconded by Barbara Kelley, the Board of Trustees voted to approve raising the cost of all school lunches by \$0.10. The motion passed unanimously.
