ATHLETIC BOOSTER CLUB MEETING
Monday, October 10, 2016

President Lowell Thompson called the meeting to order at 6:10pm. The following topics were discussed:

- The minutes from the last meeting were reviewed. Anele Richardson made a motion to accept the minutes, and Cindy Cates seconded the motion. The motion was approved.
- Financial Report – Mark Jordan was not present.

- Committee Reports

Anele Richardson made a motion that we give the money for the hotel rooms to Boys Basketball, and Jason Ray seconded. The motion passed.

It would be similar to “Meet the Tigers”, introducing the teams. Possible dates are November 1st or 3rd.

Richey Cutrer also mentioned that those responsible for the Navarro College table at the Varsity Corsicana Football games had met with Dr. Frost, and they are giving a portion of their sales to the Tiger Band. For this reason, they have been allowed to participate in pre-game sales at the Varsity Football Games.
