

CORSICANA HIGH SCHOOL
ATHLETIC BOOSTER CLUB MEETING

Monday August 14, 2017

Treasurer, Mark Jordan, in the absence of President Lowell Thompson, called the meeting to order at 6:03pm. The following topics were discussed:

- The minutes from the last meeting were reviewed. Anele Richardson made a motion to accept the minutes, and Jamie Roman seconded the motion. The motion was approved.
- Financial Report – Mark Jordan presented the financial report showing we have a balance of slightly over \$11,000. Jamie Roman made a motion to accept the report, and Anele Richardson seconded the motion. The motion was approved.
- Committee Reports
 - Jamie Roman said teams were set up to sell TNT shirts for the various Meet the Teacher Nights. Jamie reported that \$1100 was made at the Back to School Rally at the spirit trailer. Teams are already signed up to sell programs for most of the home football games. Coach Hoffman confirmed that he would have JV Football players help with the TNT kids, down on the field, as they run through the tunnel at home football games.
 - Sarah Keathley introduced Heidi from Greenworx Printing to discuss program plans. There are still a few openings in the program for this year. Because the number of ads has grown, Heidi suggested that we use a spiral binding to keep pages from coming loose with a stapled binding. There would be a \$50 difference in the cost, bringing the printing cost to \$5910. A motion was made by Jamie Roman and seconded by Anele Richardson that we use the spiral binding on the program. The motion passed.
 - Anele Richardson reported that we have about 35 Tiger Pride members. Ways to increase our membership were discussed. Mark Jordan volunteered to make a couple of contacts at the Daily Sun to see if they might do a feature story or column for the Booster Club.
 - Richey Cutrer spoke on Meet the Tiger Night, which will be held on Thursday, August 24th, at 7:30pm in the gym. Cutrer said that there seems to be a more positive atmosphere in the gym and spectators can be closer to the players on the gym floor. It was discussed that donations are still being solicited for the hot dogs, but the water has been donated by Super 1. Coach Hoffman said he would try to get some football parents to help with assembling the hot dogs that night.
- Coaches' Requests
 - Richey Cutrer introduced two new coaches: Andy Dotson, Golf coach and Atraviya Thomas, Girls' Basketball coach
 - Trainer Benny Camarillo said that he needs some small sized polos, to supplement the polos they had last year, for his smaller trainers. He needs 9 shirts at a cost of \$275, including embroidery. He also needs 24 t-shirts for this year, that the trainers will wear to various sporting events. He has found some dry-fit t-shirts for \$302. A motion was made by Anele Richardson and seconded by Jamie Roman, that \$577 be given to the trainers for the purchase of these t-shirts. The motion passed.
 - Jesus Rodriguez, Cross Country coach, said that the cross country team is in need of backpacks that they can take to meets. He needs 40 backpacks for the boys and girls. These backpacks will be turned in at the end of each year for use by the next year's team, and should be used for many years. The Nike backpacks would cost \$1587.35. A motion was made by Hayden Richardson and seconded by Anele Richardson. The motion passed.
 - Coach Hoffman said that the Football Program needs 2 new end zone cameras. These cameras are used for filming practices and for game films. The cost would be \$440. A motion was made by Anele Richardson and seconded by Jamie Roman to purchase these cameras. The motion passed.
- Richey Cutrer announced that a Division II Bowl game will most likely be played here in Corsicana on Dec. 2. This bowl game is still in negotiations, but the possibility of Corsicana being the location looks strong. This would bring a high level of football to our school and community and provide a great opportunity for students to see college athletes compete.
- A motion was made by Anele Richardson to adjourn the meeting at 6:42pm. Jamie Roman seconded the motion.
