

CORSICANA HIGH SCHOOL
ATHLETIC BOOSTER CLUB MEETING
Monday, February 11, 2019

Vice-President Sarah Keathley called the meeting to order at 6:05pm. The following topics were discussed:

- Financial Report – Mark Jordan presented a financial report, with over \$13,500 balance. Jamie Roman made a motion to accept the report as presented. Andrea Braswell seconded the motion and the motion passed.
- Committee Reports
 - Jamie Roman reported that the scholarship application is ready for the Booster Club scholarships for 2019. She will send the applications to Tara Podjenski, CHS Senior counselor. The applications will be due toward the end of April. It was decided to award one \$500 scholarship to a boy athlete and one to a girl athlete. It was discussed that we might do a specific fundraiser for scholarships in the Fall and possibly be able to offer more than 2 scholarships next year.
 - Andrea Braswell said that she is open to ideas for the gift that we include with 2019 - 2020 Tiger Pride memberships.
 - Coach Hal Wasson suggested that we might do a fundraiser raffle in conjunction with the Meet the Tigers rally in August. We could get donations from the community as prizes. This has proven to be successful in some schools where he has previously coached.
- Coaches' Requests
 - Coach Wasson said that Spring Practices will begin April 23th. He would like to purchase a portable music box, which doubles as a PA system, for the Football Team to use during practices and in the weight room. After discussion, it was decided that the Booster Club could give money toward this purchase, with the school also contributing to this purchase. A motion was made by Mark Jordan and seconded by Jamie Roman that the Booster Club donate \$2000 toward the purchase of this music box/PA system. The motion passed.
 - Coach Braziel reported that it will soon be Texas Relay time for the Track team. He is working on getting hotel rooms for the team, and will bring a request for assistance to the next meeting.
 - Richey Cutrer reported that Coach Hoffman had informed him that there was a shortage of \$150 for meals for the football banquet. Jamie Roman made a motion that we pay for the extra meals, and it was seconded by Chuck Tidwell. The motion passed.
- A discussion was held about getting more parents and community members to come to the Booster Club Meetings. Coach Wasson discussed some ideas that had worked for him in the past to create excitement and involvement.
- A motion was made by Jamie Roman to adjourn the meeting at 6:45pm. Andrea Braswell seconded the motion.
- The next meeting will be March 4th at 6:00pm in the Community Room at Tiger Stadium. The meeting will be held one week earlier than normal because of Spring Break.
