ATHLETIC BOOSTER CLUB MEETING

Monday, July 8, 2019

- Vice-President Sarah Keathley called the meeting to order at 6:00pm. The following topics were discussed:
- The June minutes were presented. Treasurer Mark Jordan was not present, but Sarah Keathley reported that we have a \$4978.06 balance.
- Committee Reports
 - Heidi from Greenworx Printing reported on the football programs, saying we had a choice of what type binding to use for the programs this year. The square back binding has a limit of 60 pages, where the spiral finish has unlimited pages. It was discussed that we could wait until the August meeting to make that decision, based on the number of ads that have been sold at that time. Jamie reported that she has put ad announcements on Facebook. Sarah reported that letters have gone out to businesses, and Tara Podjenski has been notified to help spread the word about senior ads.
 - Andrea Braswell reported that the Tiger car flags have been ordered for the Tiger Pride membership gifts. It was discussed that we need to go to the various sports' parent meetings to boost sales of Tiger Pride memberships.
 - Jamie Roman reported that 500 TNT t-shirts have been ordered, and they are yellow with a football logo on them. We will once again sell the t-shirts at the Back to School rally, and also at the various Meet the Teacher Nights.
 - Meet the Tiger Night was discussed. Richey Cutrer said that it will either have to be August 15th or 21st, depending on when certain teams have games. A decision will be made soon. Jamie volunteered to send out letters to businesses asking for donations for hot dogs and water for that night.
- Coaches' Requests
 - Coach Gentry, the new girls' volleyball coach, requested funds for new Under Armour traveling suits for the Varsity team. 15 suits will cost \$1185. It is volleyball's year to get new clothing/uniforms under the Under Armour agreement.
- Sarah Keathley reported that Treasurer Mark Jordan has resigned. Since President Lowell Thompson's death has already created an opening for Booster Club Officers, it was decided that an election of new officers needs to be held in August.
- Sarah Keathley made a motion to pass a resolution to add Secretary Melanie Tidwell to sign checks, along with herself, for one month, to take care of immediate business until new elections can be held. Jamie Roman seconded the motion, and the motion passed.
- Sarah reported that she would check with the Post Office about getting a key so that we can get correspondence from our post office box.
- It was discussed that we have two banking accounts. Money from our square, which is used in the Booster Club trailer, goes to Community National Bank. All other money goes to our new non-profit status account at City National. It was discussed that we need to withdraw some money from the CNB account and make a deposit into the City National Bank account so that we have operating money. This would last until we can establish one bank account under our non-profit status. Several of the members said they would check with various institutions to see if we can find a bank that would not charge fees for a non-profit group.
- Jamie Roman stated that she would like to order 100 large flags to be sold in the trailer, along with a hoodie that is uniform approved. She has also had people inquire about a less expensive Tiger shirt, and she had found some suitable shirts to order for Booster Club trailer sales too.
- Melanie Tidwell read a thank you note from Mariah Lee, for the scholarship that the Booster Club awarded to her.
- The next meeting will be August 12th at 6:00pm in the Community Room at Tiger Stadium.
