

**CORSICANA HIGH SCHOOL**  
**ATHLETIC BOOSTER CLUB MEETING**  
**Monday, August 5, 2019**

- Vice-President Sarah Keathley called the meeting to order at 6:05pm. Kenya Landers, Assistant Principal at CHS, welcomed the crowd and stated that she was there in the place of Shade Boulware and Hal Wasson, who were at other school events. The following topics were discussed:
- The July minutes were presented. Anele Richardson made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Brandy Harrison seconded the motion and the motion passed. Sarah Keathley reported that we have a \$12,056.78 balance.
- Committee Reports
  - Sarah reported that we have sold approximately \$10,000 in ads for the football program.
  - Andrea Braswell reported that sales are continuing for Tiger Pride, and we will try to go to as many team meetings as possible to promote membership. The cards to get in the games, plus the flags, will be available for members to pick up in the Spirit Trailer.
  - The TNT t-shirts are ready to be sold at the Back to School rally, and also at the various Meet the Teacher Nights. Teams are needed to sell the t-shirts. A note will be sent to coaches to fill this need.
  - Meet the Tiger Night will be Monday, August 19<sup>th</sup> at 7:00pm. Plans to meet early that evening were discussed to set up for the rally, get the water iced down, hot dogs cooked, etc. Football parents will be available to help also.
- Coaches' Requests – there were none
- Sarah Keathley reported that since Treasurer Mark Jordan has resigned, along with the death of President Lowell Thompson, an election of officers needs to be held. A slate of officers was formed by the Executive Committee. Sarah Keathley explained to the membership that the slate of officers could be voted in, or we could hold individual elections for each office. By a show of hands, it was decided to accept the slate of officers.

- Jennifer Farmer brought up the need for a new fog machine to be used when the Tigers run through the tunnel onto the football field. In the past, fire extinguishers have been used. But the fire extinguishers are old, outdated, and considered a safety hazard. Jennifer made the motion that the Booster Club spend approximately \$400 for a new fog machine and fog making ingredients. The motion was seconded by Missy Grantham and the motion passed. It was discussed that this fog machine could be made available for use by other sports teams.
- Collin Street Bakery community representative, Chris Woolsey, attended the meeting to present the Booster Club with a check to cover the cost of a football team meal, a full page program ad, and TNT sponsorship. He spoke of the importance to team sports and thanked the Booster Club for supporting the kids of our community.
- Shade Boulware was able to come to the last of the meeting and welcome those present, and express his appreciation for the efforts of the Booster Club in supporting extracurricular activities. He stated that he is excited about his new role, and urged us to hold to the motto “TCC” – to Take Care of Corsicana. He said it had created a culture change at CHS, and we need to keep encouraging our students to be their best. It was discussed that we will encourage each coach to provide one parent from each sport to attend Booster Club meetings, hoping to increase participation and promote more communication.
- Andrea Braswell brought up that she would like to use QuickBooks as the new treasurer. She felt it was especially important with our new non-profit status and the requirements we will have with taxes. She wanted to use the \$240/year online version. A motion was made by Andrea to pay for this program. It was seconded by Brandy Harrison and the motion passed. Andrea stated that she will be working to get a new bank account opened, with the non-profit status, based on discussions regarding this matter at the last meeting. All officers will be listed on the account, and each check will require two signatures.
- The meeting adjourned at 6:40.
