## ATHLETIC BOOSTER CLUB MEETING

Monday, September 9, 2019

- President Sarah Keathley called the meeting to order at 6:05pm. The following topics were discussed:
- The August minutes were presented. Brandy Harrison made a motion to accept the minutes as presented. Jennifer Farmer seconded the motion and the motion passed.
- Treasurer Andrea Braswell reported that we have not been able to get QuikBooks yet until we can consolidate our bank accounts. She reported that we have \$22,482 in the accounts at this time.
  - Sarah Keathley made a motion to add Andrea Braswell's name to our two bank accounts at City National Bank and Community National Bank. Jennifer Farmer seconded the motion and the motion passed.
- Committee Reports
  - Sarah reported that of the 400 programs we had, 237 were sold at the first home game.
  - Andrea Braswell reported that we have approximately 50 members, having had 60 in 2018. Andrea suggested that we make a push to sell more memberships once basketball season starts.
  - It was discussed that we sold \$158 in tickets for the Meet the Tiger Night raffle. It was mentioned that we might have more success if we can sell the tickets ahead of time next year. We also decided to look at the number of hotdogs to cook next year and make sure we can utilize the usual 500.
- Coaches' Requests – there were none
  - Caleb Coy, soccer coach, was present and said they may ask for help with sideline jackets or backpacks sometime this year.
  - Nic Claiborne, boys basketball coach, was present and said they will probably need help with new Under Armour uniforms later in the year.
  - Mashequa Gentry was present to report that the new volleyball sweats were in, and thanked the Booster Club for the help. She stated that the girls are excited to have the new sweats.
  - Angela Rash, cross country coach, was present and thanked the Booster Club for the work they do.
- Jennifer Farmer said that she had a conversation with Football coach, Hal Wasson, and he wants to increase excitement in town about the Tiger Football team. Jennifer asked for help in purchasing some signs to put up around the school and town with various Tiger sayings, to help generate more interest and excitement about the various CISD teams. These could be kept at the athletic facilities and used for various games, playoffs, etc. of all sports. Jennifer gave some quotes that she had received, and some mock-ups that had been given to her. A motion was made by Brandy Harrison to authorize Jennifer to spend \$500 toward the signs. Will Dixon seconded the motion and the motion passed. It was discussed that we might sell these signs to various businesses / individuals in town that request one.
- The possibility of changing our meeting time was discussed, as the Booster Club typically meets the same night that the School Board meets. This prevents some people from coming to the Booster Club meeting. It was decided to change the meeting date to the 1<sup>st</sup> Monday of the month instead of the 2<sup>nd</sup> Monday of the month. Jennifer Farmer made a motion to change our meeting date to the 1<sup>st</sup> Monday of the month. Will Dixon seconded the motion and the motion passed.
- Will Dixon made a motion to adjourn the meeting and Jennifer Farmer seconded the motion. The meeting adjourned at 6:40.
