ATHLETIC BOOSTER CLUB MEETING

Monday, August 10, 2015

President Lowell Thompson called the meeting to order at 6:13pm. The following topics were discussed:

- Minutes from the previous meeting held on July 13th, were distributed to those present. The motion was made by Mark Jordan and seconded by Anele Richardson to approve the minutes as distributed. All approved.
- Financial Report – Mark Jordan reported that there is \$14, 254.37 in the account. A motion was made by Cindy Cates, and seconded by Sarah Keathley that the Financial Report be approved as presented. All approved.
- Committee Reports
 - Tigers in Training / Tiger Store – Jamie Roman reported that the trailer is ready to be used. A discussion was held on whose name should be on the trailer title. President Lowell Thompson said that he will look into this issue. Lowell also mentioned that we may eventually need a generator for this trailer. We will also need insurance, at least liability. Jamie and Lowell will investigate some insurance prices for the Booster Club. Jamie also reported that TNT has secured \$5200 in sponsorships. Jamie has ordered 600 shirts, to be sold for \$10 each. Our net profit should be \$8236. The order forms will be at all the Meet the Teacher nights, with the softball and basketball girls staffing the order form table. Jamie also stated that we need groups to sign up to sell programs and trailer spirit items at the home football games.
 - Tiger Pride - Anele Richardson reported that all the ads for the football program had sold out, with a great deal more senior ads than we have had in the past. She also stated that the money collections were going well for these ads. Anele said that Tiger Pride membership sales were also going well, and the membership gift seats were in for members to pick up.
 - Meet the Tigers - There were enough donations for Meet the Tigers to cover the costs of serving hot dogs and water. Someone suggested that we have KAND and The Ranch advertise this event for us. Melanie Tidwell stated that she would send out thank you notes to those businesses that made contributions.
- Richey Cutrer reported that all three pieces of the Tiger tunnel and balloons had been taken by Tony Newsome to Dallas for repair. It was not known how much it would cost to repair these balloons. However the Booster Club would need to reimburse Mr. Newsome, but Mr. Newsome would let us know the amount before the repairs were completed. A motion was made by Melanie Tidwell, and seconded by Jamie Roman, that the Booster Club reimburse Mr. Newsome up to a cost of \$500 for these repairs. All approved. A discussion was also brought up about building a new “Tiger Cage” for the football team to use to run out on the field. Lowell Thompson stated that he would look into how we could get this done. Cutrer asked Coach Hoffman to think about what he wants for the cage.
- Coaches’ requests – Richey Cutrer asked the coaches in attendance to introduce themselves.
 - Ashley Grace stated that the girls Volleyball Team would be going to tournaments in Richardson and Rockwall in August. She requested \$500 from the Booster Club to cover the cost of hotel rooms. A motion was made by Anele Richardson, and seconded by Mark Jordan, that we give this amount to the Volleyball Team. All approved.
 - Coach Landers stated that the girls Basketball Team would be in a tournament December 28-30. She stated that they would need hotel rooms for this tournament. Since she did not know a specific amount yet, it was decided that she would come back at a later date with the specific amount needed.
- The next meeting will be September 14th, 2015 at 6:00pm in the Community Room at Tiger Stadium. President Lowell Thompson urged each member to bring one new person with them for the next meeting.
- A motion was made by Anele Richardson for the meeting to be adjourned at 6:45pm. The motion was seconded by Jason Ray.
