ATHLETIC BOOSTER CLUB MEETING

Monday, September 14, 2015

Treasurer Mark Jordan, in the absence of President Lowell Thompson, called the meeting to order at 6:03pm. The following topics were discussed:

- Minutes from the previous meeting held on August 10th, were distributed to those present. The motion was made by Gwen Woods and seconded by Jamie Roman to approve the minutes as distributed. All approved.
- Financial Report – Mark Jordan reported that there is \$15,568.33 in the account. A motion was made by Anele Richardson, and seconded by Jamie Roman that the Financial Report be approved as presented. All approved.
- Guest Lori Haynie spoke on behalf of the Class of 2012 regarding a class fundraiser in memory of Dequan Raindle. Lori's daughter, Carly, a classmate of Dequan's, designed a car decal that the class is selling to fund a scholarship account at Community National Bank. They have raised \$2500 already, and want to sell the car decals in the Booster Club Trailer during the football games. Classmates would help run the sales. It was the general consensus that we allow these sales, seeing as this is a worthwhile endeavor to help honor a classmate and honor a future CISD graduate with a scholarship.
- Committee Reports
 - Tigers in Training / Tiger Store – Jamie Roman reported that the trailer is in use and we are waiting for the trailer invoice. Jamie also reported that about 600 t-shirts have been sold, and the Booster Club should see about \$9000 profit. Jamie still has t-shirts for sale and yard signs for \$10 each. The Pink Out game will be Oct. 23rd, and the Blue Out game will be Nov. 6th. Jamie also stated that we need groups to sign up to sell programs and trailer spirit items at the home football games. Jamie also reported that the Tiger Cage is being built, and we are waiting on prices for the paw prints.
 - Tiger Pride - Anele Richardson reported that we have 64 Tiger Pride members. Memberships and chairs are still available. All but 4 or 5 are paid for, so the collections are going well.
- Coaches' requests – there were no requests.
- Dena Gilmore was present to voice her concern over the cheerleaders not having a charter bus for travel to out of town football games. Mark explained to Dena that this was not anything the Booster Club handles, and that she should voice her concern to the School Board.
