Purpose of the ARP ESSER III funds:

The purpose of the grant funds, in general, is meant to help schools recover from the effects of the coronavirus pandemic and to address student learning loss.

- Grant Timeline: The grant funding ends on September 30, 2024.
- Review: Plans will be reviewed and adjusted every 6 months as necessary to evaluate effectiveness and continued impact on students.
- Six-month Review: January 7, 2022
- Consultation: CISD has gathered input from our stakeholders to create a plan for using the resources.

District Allocation

The intent of ESSER III funding is to help safely reopen and sustain the safe operation of schools and address the impact of the coronavirus pandemic on students.

Learning Loss – Items to address learning loss must exceed 20% of the grant funding. (\$2,600,000)


CISD Total allocation: \$12,795,116
