Purpose of the CRRSA ESSER II funds

The intent and purpose of the CRRSA Act of 2021, ESSER II funding, is to prevent, prepare for, or respond to the COVID-19 pandemic, including its impact on the social, emotional, mental health, and academic needs of students.

- Grant Timeline: The grant funding ends on September 30, 2023.
- Consultation: CISD has gathered input to create a plan for using the resources.

District Allocation

ESSER II funds are designated for one-time or short-term expenditures to address the impact of the pandemic.

The intention of these funds is to facilitate learning acceleration that is necessary to support students affected by COVID-19.

Total CISD allotment: \$5,695,367
