Effective August 1, 2019, all students (reduced and full price from all grade levels) will be able to charge three (3) consecutive lunch meals. This would provide a student who does not have lunch money to charge three (3) consecutive lunch meals without payment. Charges will be added to the students meal account for the three (3) consecutive days the student charged the meals. If a student does not have lunch money for the next day after he/she has charged meals for three (3) consecutive days, the current charge guidelines will go into effect in which the student will receive an alternate meal such as a cheese sandwich with a choice of milk. Charge letters are sent home with students who have a low/negative meal account balance. Parents are responsible to repay cafeterias for all meal charges. This charge guideline does not cover ala carte items.

Example: A Full Paid Elementary/Intermediate student who does not have lunch money will be charged \$2.25 each day for lunch. If a student does not bring lunch money for three (3) consecutive days, he/she will have charged a total of \$6.75. A Reduced-Priced Elementary/Intermediate student who does not have lunch money for three (3) consecutive days will be charge \$0.40 cent each day for lunch. If the student does not bring lunch money for three (3) consecutive days he/she will have charged a total \$1.20.

Example: A High/Middle School Student who does not have lunch money will be charged \$2.65 each day for lunch. If a student does not bring lunch money for three (3) consecutive days, he/she will have charged a total \$7.95. A Reduced-Priced High/Middle School Student who does not have lunch money will be charged \$.40 each day for lunch. If the student does not bring money for three (3) consecutive days he/she will have charged a total of \$1.20

Once the student has reached his/her three (3) day charge limit, he/she will receive an alternative meal (cheese sandwich with a choice of milk) at no cost to the student.

Low/ Negative balance charge letters will be sent home twice a week (Tuesday and Thursday) with students to keep parents updated on their negative balance.

A Partir 01 de Agosto 2019, todos los estudiantes (reduccion de precios y completa de todos los grados) estaran en condiciones de cobrar tres (3) comidas de almuerzo. Esto permitira a un estudiante sin dinero para el almuerzo que se ofrece tres comidas (3) almuerzo y sin pago. Si el estudiante no tiene dinero para el almuerzo para los proximos tres (3) dias despues de la politica actual del nino que recibe una comida alternativa, como un sandwich de queso y leche, entraria en vigor. Letras de carga seran enviados a casa con los estudiantes que tienen un balance de la cuenta de alimentos de bajo o negativo. Se espera que los padres de familia pagan al las cafeterias. Esta politica cargo no cubre articulos A La Carta.

Ejemplo: Un estudiantes de primaria / intermedio que no tiene dinero para el almuerzo se le cobrara \$2.25 cada dia. Se el estudiante no trae dinero para el almuerzo para los tres (3) dias, el / ella habra cobrado un total de \$6.75. Un estudiante de primaria / intermedio de precio reducido que no tiene dinero para almuerzo se le cobrara \$0.40 cada dia. Si el estudiante no trae dinero para el almuerzo para los tres (3) dias el / ella Habra cobrado un total \$1.20.

Ejemplo: Un estudiante de High / Middle School que no tiene dinero para almuerzo se le cobrara \$2.65 cada dia. Se el estudiante no trae dinero para el almuerzo para los tres (3) dias, el / ella habra cobrado un total de \$7.95. Un estudiante de High / Middle School de precio reducido que no tiene dinero para almuerzo se le cobrara \$0.40 cada dia. Si el estudiante no trae dinero para el almuerzo para los tres (3) dias el / ella Habra cobrado un total \$1.20.

Una vez que el estudiante ha alcanzado su limite de tres (3) dias de carga, el / ella recibira una comida alternativa (sandwich de queso y leche) a no costo para el estudiante.

Letras de carga baja y negativo balance seran enviados a casa dos veces por semana (martes y viernes) para mantener a los padres actualizados en su saldo negative de los estudiantes.

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
