

Fine Arts and Computer Lab Grading Policy

Participation Grade:

The Fine Arts and Computer Lab grade is largely a participation grade. Each student starts the 9-week grading period with a 100. If a student participates consistently and does their best, they will keep that 100. In Fine Arts, older students may have a few individually graded assignments in addition to their participation grade.

If a student chooses to break the rules and sit out for a portion of class, the student will lose 2 points from his/her participation grade since a student cannot participate in class activities when sitting out.

Citizenship Grade:

If a student needs to sit out from class activities on 3 separate days in a 9-week grading period, a letter grade will be deducted from the student's citizenship grade.

Referral to the Office results in an automatic deduction of one letter grade from a student's citizenship grade.
