## The Kite Runner Project

Directions: Create a kite based on your knowledge of The Kite Runner. Each panel will represent one of the following key points:

- Theme- Choose one major theme reflected in the work. On one portion of the kite, name your theme, and provide visual representations of that theme using magazine cut-outs, computer images, drawings, etc.
- Character- Choose one major character and visual representations of that character.
- Turning points- There are many important turning points in the story. Choose one and include a visual representation.
- Symbols-We all know that the kite is an important symbol in the story, symbolizing Amir's self-torture and eventually the release of his guilt. Select another significant symbol from the novel.
- Explanations: In well-developed paragraphs, on a separate sheet, explain the information on your kite. You must justify your selections and visual representations. Explain the theme you selected-prove it through textual evidence; explain how your selected character changed throughout the novel (with text evidence); explain the turning point (with text evidence support); and explain the symbols using text evidence to support your choice.

Kite tail-Provide three visual representations of Amir's transformation from childhood to adulthood.
