What Does the 8th Amendment Say?

Excessive bail shall not be required, nor excessive fines imposed, nor cruel and unusual punishments inflicted.

Purpose of Excessive Bail Clause

■ What is bail? Why is it used?

To prevent a court from setting an amount of bail so high that a defendant cannot possibly pay

What Determines Cruel and Unusual Punishment?

1. Punishment must not involve the unnecessary and wanton infliction of pain.

2. The punishment must not be grossly out of proportion to the severity of the crime.
