Electoral College

Basic things to know

- Based upon the states (i.e. the states choose the president)
- # of votes is based upon representation in Congress (HofR + Senators)
- Texas has 38
- Winner take all (except in Maine & Nebraska)
- ▶ Faithless Electors electors can vote for whomever they want
- Baseball/tennis/volleyball analogy

Why this system?

- Logistics
- Didn't trust democracy
- States saw themselves as independent nations

Arguments to keep Electoral College

- It works
- Rarely contradicts popular vote (2016)
- Smaller states would be ignored
- Large population centers would choose president not whole nation

Arguments to get rid of Electoral College

- Reason for system does not apply today
- Every other election is based upon the popular vote
- ▶ It is disproportional... Small states have more say than large states
 - ▶ Wyoming has 1 electoral college vote for every 166.666 people
 - ► Texas has 1 electoral college vote for every 789,473
- Violates "one man, one vote" concept
