## Basic things to know

- Based upon the states (i.e. the states choose the president)
- \# of votes is based upon representation in Congress (HofR + Senators)
- Texas has 38
- Winner take all (except in Maine \& Nebraska)
- Faithless Electors - electors can vote for whomever they want
- Baseball/tennis/volleyball analogy


## Why this system?

- Logistics
- Didn'† trust democracy
- States saw themselves as independent nations


## Arguments to keep Electoral College

- It works
- Rarely contradicts popular vote (2016)
- Smaller states would be ignored
- Large population centers would choose president not whole nation


## Arguments to get rid of Electoral College

- Reason for system does not apply today
- Every other election is based upon the popular vote
- It is disproportional... Small states have more say than large states
- Wyoming has 1 electoral college vote for every 166.666 people
- Texas has 1 electoral college vote for every 789,473
- Violates "one man, one vote" concept
