Superintendent's Report

Code to the Future has successfully started at Bowie Elementary and they are gearing up for Epic Build in October. Lisa West submitted a grant for the Drane Learning Center "Community Gardens" and received \$10,000 from the Texas Department of Agriculture. The garden will serve as a learning tool for Pre-K and Early Childhood students with help from CHS Mentors from Career and Technology, FFA, Ag-Tech, Culinary Arts, Woodworking and Turning Points who will play a role in development and lead the process through plant life cycles. Eventually there will be a sampling of "Farm Fresh" food on Fridays.

Cross Country in Cleburne had three individual medalists and placed 7th out of 31 teams. Tennis is 8 and 2 overall for the season. The football team defeated Greenville with a score of 20-7 for a current 2 and 1 record. Volleyball is 13 - 13 and had an intense 5-game set and lost by only a few points against Ennis.
