Dressing Rooms

- Will be opened 2 ½ hours prior to game time
- Teams may have electrolyte drinks in the dressing rooms but **NOT** on the field.
 - Only water will be allowed on the field.
- ♦ CISD does not provide towels.
- Visiting schools should remove valuable articles from the dressing areas. CISD is not responsible for articles left in the dressing rooms before, during, or after the game.

Parking

- All lots adjacent to the stadium are reserved parking. General parking for the home side is available west of the stadium off HWY 744.
- ♦ All visitor fan parking is located on the east side of the stadium and in the Corsicana High School parking lot east of the stadium.
- Team buses will load, unload, and park directly behind the field house.
- Band, drill team, cheerleader, and other support buses will park in the strip parking lot on the south-east side of the stadium.

Playing Field

- There will be No air horns or mechanical noisemakers allowed in the stadium.
- All team personnel who are not in game uniform must have a sideline pass. This includes coaches, trainers, student trainers, student managers, team doctors, and all other support staff.
- Cheerleaders and mascots who are in uniform do not need a pass, but their support staff members need passes.
- Media personnel must display sideline passes to enter the field.
- No food, tobacco, sunflower seeds or gum will be allowed on the field.
- Only water may be consumed on the field. No electrolyte drinks such as Gatorade or other "colored" drinks may be brought onto the field. Drinks must be served in cups or plastic bottles. Glass containers or cans are not allowed on the field.
- ♦ All equipment, such as fans, heaters, tables, etc. must have a protective base to prevent damage to the field or track.
- Live mascots will not be allowed in the stadium.
- Confetti, ignited cannons or other pyrotechnic items will not be allowed on stadium property.
- All team run-through signs and spirit signs must be vinyl/cloth with permanent paint or marking materials which will not "run" when wet. Spirit signs and banners may only be hung with wire or ties. The use of tape or other adhesive materials to hang signs is prohibited.
- Paper signs and banners are not allowed in the stadium.
- Band, drill team or cheerleader props and equipment must not mark or scar the field or track. This includes painted items as well as sharp wheels or other equipment that may damage the playing surface or track.
- Ice Chests will not be allowed on the field, unless being used by the contestants, cheerleaders, bands or drill teams
- Spectators are not allowed on the field before, during or after a game unless they have sideline passes.
- Run-through tunnels are allowed on the field prior to the game and second half; however, personnel providing the tunnels must exit the playing field prior to the kick-off.



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Press Box

- ♦ Admittance to the press box is by pass only. All passes will be issued by the stadium manager in advance.
 - Temporary passes allowing a single trip to the press box are issued by the Athletic Department or stadium personnel at the base of the elevator. These passes are also for band and drill team personnel that may require access at half-time.
- ♦ Media personnel must call the CISD Public Relations office (903-874-7441) to be put on the press box list prior to game day.
- All team personnel must display a pass from their head coach/designee prior to entering the press box.
- ♦ The press box will be open 1 ½ hours prior to game time.

Security

• Security will be provided to monitor locker rooms, restrooms, concessions, ticket booths, parking and near entrances and exits of our stadium for your safety. Anyone that is found to be disruptive, uncontrollable or not following the stadium guidelines will be asked to leave the premises.

Entrance Gates

- Fan gates will be opened 1 ½ hours prior to game time..
- All visiting band, drill, and cheerleader groups must enter through the SE gate. All students must be in their
 organizational uniform.
 - Any student managers, adult chaperones, or sponsors must enter with their group. They all must be identifiable by badge, pass, or uniform.
- Once the group enters the stadium, there are no "in-out" privileges.
- There will be no in and out privileges. Reentry requires another ticket purchase.
- No outside food or drinks may be brought into the stadium.
- UIL District Passes (example 8-5A), THSCA, and THSGCA are the only passes accepted. They may be used at any ticket gate.
- Spectators will not be allowed entrance to the "wrong side" of the stadium. Tickets are specific to the home
 or visitor section and tickets are not valid for access to the opposite side.

Corsicana Student Section

- All students entering and exiting Section A must do so from the bottom stairs.
- Students with a reserved ticket should keep the ticket stub to enter the reserved section.
